

About Us



Special Service Area (SSA) #39 is managed by the Back of the Yards Neighborhood Council (BYNC). Established in 2007, SSA #39 works with more than 420 businesses located in the Brighton Park and Archer Heights neighborhoods.

Funded through a modest property tax levy, SSA #39 is able to provide "special services" that extend far beyond what the City of Chicago offers. These services include, but are not limited to: graffiti removal, advertising rebates and seasonal shopping promotions, storefront renovation rebates, vacant commercial property marketing, shopper shuttle bus service, and strategic planning for the Archer Avenue retail district.

Since its inception, SSA #39 has:

- Repaired over 1,000 storefront windows and doors.
- Distributed more than \$205,000 in façade improvement rebates since 2013, with an additional \$75,000 anticipated in the current year.
- Invested in corridor beautification and planning efforts to enhance physical conditions at the building and street level, improve parking, create a more pedestrian-friendly environment, and bring innovative and feasible ideas to the retail district.








Community Overview
